## COMPOSITION - CLASS MATERIAL LIST

Notebook or journal and pen for taking notes, recording studies

General drawing supplies:

variety of pencils, for instance 3B, 2B, HB, 2H  
eraser, sharpener  
felt-tip marker in fine, medium and wide tip, black  
black ink  
inexpensive or old brush for ink (not one you'll use later for watercolor)

Other student-grade art supplies:

(what you already have is likely sufficient)  
watercolor paints in a few basic colors, brushes  
colored pencils  
Crayola crayons (yup, take 'em from the kids)

Papers:

pack of construction paper in variety of colors, 8.5"x11" or larger  
several sheets of matte black construction paper, 8.5"x11 and 11x17"  
drawing paper or pad 14x17, smooth or vellum finish in a weight that can take a light wash, example Strathmore 400 Series, Drawing Paper, brown cover  
pad of inexpensive tracing paper  
Glue stick  
Scissors, x-acto knife and blade if preferred, with cutting surface  
Straight edge: ruler, 12" plastic triangle, small T-square if you have one
