Drawing Surfaces: The School will sell individual sheets of these at cost to students:
Strathmore Bristol, Smooth, Series 500, 14" x 17"
Duralar Acetate Clear Film

Ink: Rapidograph, Black India Ink

Drawing Instruments: Pencils, 2B, 4H

1 plastic Crowquill Nib Holder, Hunt #9452, Type A
1 plastic Crowquill Nib Holder, Hunt #9454, Type C

Hunt Nibs, sizes 102 (moderately fine) and 104 (very fine)
(Buy two of each as they may break in use.)

Optional: Rapidograph Pen, 3x0/.25 (used for stipples)

Other: 6" or 12" ruler with metric and inches
Small soft rag – lint free
Cellulose sponge – cut to 2" x 3"
Exacto knife with fine point #11 blade
Sataedter Mars Plastic eraser
White artists tape
Magnifying glass
Small plastic jar with lid that closes to hold ammonia
Derma Glove (white soft cotton gloves - find in drugstore pharmacies)
